1. What do you think are the biggest challenges facing single women in their late teens and twenties as they navigate dating, sexual expectations, and pursuing marriage in today's culture?
2. What are the challenges faced by women in their thirties and older as they navigate dating, sexual expectations, and pursuing marriage? Are they different? Why or why not?
3. Are there *women you are close to in your life* who could use positive redirection in the realms of sex, dating, and marriage? What do they need to hear?
4. Do you feel equipped to talk to them? Why or why not? If not, what support do you need to do this, and how can you find this support? Think about asking WSFT for what you need and we'll think hard about it with you!
5. Do you remember the "one improvement" you talked about during your first WSFT Gathering—one thing your *wider community and town* may need for redirection on sex, marriage, and kids? Is part of the answer to this problem an increase in mentorship or positive personal friendships where these topics are discussed?
